- CPCS Driver Competency for Heavy Plant eg 360 excavators and above and below 5 tonne
- General Construction Operatives Safety Awareness
- Slinging
- Street Works
- Confined Space Training

Our Site Managers and Contract Managers additionally hold:

- CITB Site Management Safety Training Scheme (5 day course)
- CSCS Supervisor Cards
- First Aid at Work
- Various CTA plant cards

Furthermore we have carried out and obtained the following specialist training:

- ARCA Asbestos Awareness Course
- Use of Cable Avoiding Tools
- Powered Access Vehicles
- Erection of Scaffold Towers
- Site Safety Awareness
- CITB / NFDC Competency Cards for Demolition Operatives
